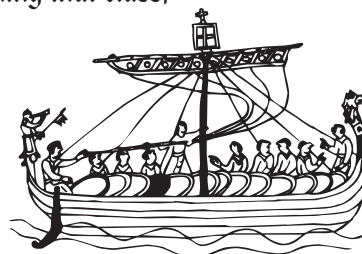

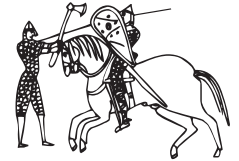
This meeting is to go thru all the shire inventory and put it together according to area of use vs. just in tubs. This should help with on site organization and efficiency.

## Arts & Sciences

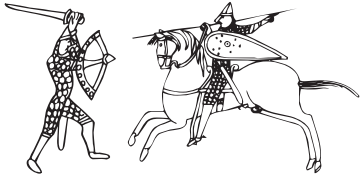

## Meridian Grand Tournament Update

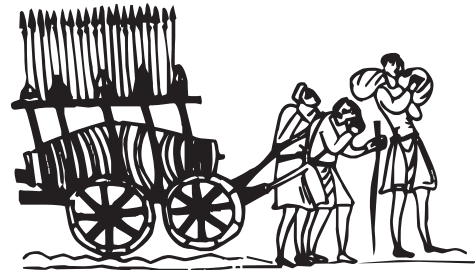
